Traffick Jam Community Workshops bring community residents, elected officials and police together to learn about the connection between gun violence and the business of trafficking that makes it possible. Participants learn how police track guns, how loopholes in state and federal laws contribute to trafficking, and steps they can take to shut down the “Iron Pipeline” that puts guns in the hands of criminals and young people.

Traffick Jam is a multi-media, interactive workshop that was developed by Citizens for Safety, law enforcement professionals, and community advocates to unite citizens with police and local officials in the fight to curb gun trafficking.

Benefits of Traffick Jam Community Workshops:

- Unites community and police to keep illegal guns out of the hands of criminals and youth
- Trains community organizers and residents to carry information about gun trafficking to other community members and the media
- Inspires citizens to stay involved in efforts to curb gun trafficking
- Builds grassroots support for policy solutions

Citizens for Safety works with mayors and other elected officials, law enforcement agencies and community groups to conduct Traffick Jam Community Workshops in neighborhoods affected by gun violence.
